Section 9.4.4(B)(8) Ferrous or Nonferrous metallic mineral exploration as defined in 295.44(1)(h) or 293.01(5) Wisconsin Statutes as amended pursuant to license under 293.21 Wisconsin Statutes as amended and any other required state, federal, or municipal permits provided no more than five (5) exploratory borings may be drilled per acre per year nor more than ten (10) per acre every five (5) years in which case further exploration shall be a conditional use.

## Addition to Section 9.4.5 A-1 Primary Agricultural District. Permitted Uses.

Section 9.4.5(B)(12) Ferrous or Nonferrous metallic mineral exploration as defined in 295.44(1)(h) or 293.01(5) Wisconsin Statutes as amended pursuant to license under 293.21 Wisconsin Statutes as amended and any other required state, federal, or municipal permits provided no more than five (5) exploratory borings may be drilled per acre per year nor more than ten (10) per acre every five (5) years in which case further exploration shall be a conditional use.

## Addition to Section 9.4.6 A-2 Agricultural District. Permitted Uses.

Section 9.4.6(B)(24) Ferrous or Nonferrous metallic mineral exploration as defined in 295.44(1)(h) or 293.01(5) Wisconsin Statutes as amended pursuant to license under 293.21 Wisconsin Statutes as amended and any other required state, federal, or municipal permits provided no more than five (5) exploratory borings may be drilled per acre per year nor more than ten (10) per acre every five (5) years in which case further exploration shall be a conditional use.

Section 9.4.7(B)(18) Ferrous or Nonferrous metallic mineral exploration as defined in 295.44(1)(h) or 293.01(5) Wisconsin Statutes as amended pursuant to license under 293.21 Wisconsin Statutes as amended and any other required state, federal, or municipal permits provided no more than five (5) exploratory borings may be drilled per acre per year nor more than ten (10) per acre every five (5) years in which case further exploration shall be a conditional use.
