



REGISTER OF DEEDS FEE SCHEDULE

Recorded Documents

Deeds, Mortgages, Land Contracts, Satisfactions, etc.: \$11 for the first page and \$2 for each additional page per document. NOTE: first page must have blank recording area in upper right hand corner or else add cover page for an additional \$2.

Termination of Decedent's Property Interest: \$25
HT-110 forms are provided for this type of probate.

Transfer on Death to Beneficiary: \$25
TOD-110 forms are provided for this type of probate.

Copies of Recorded Documents

Uncertified copies of the above documents are available for \$2 for the first page and \$1 for each additional page. An additional \$1 is charged for a certified copy. If you do not know the document number, volume and page or how many pages are in the document, there is an extra search fee of _____.

Filed Plats

Plats (Cemetery, Condominium & Subdivision): \$50

Transportation Project Plats: \$25 (each sheet is a plat)

Vital Records

Birth Certificate: \$20 for the first copy and \$3 for each additional copy per order.
(\$15 of this fee goes to fund state programs.)

Death Certificate: \$20 for the first copy and \$3 for each additional copy per order.
(\$13 of this fee goes to fund state programs.)

Marriage Certificate: \$20 for the first copy and \$3 for each additional copy per order.
(\$13 of this fee goes to fund state programs.)

Expedite Fee: \$20 (\$10 of this fee goes to fund state programs)

Verification Fee: \$7 (No copy issued)

Search fee: \$7 (Plus reasonable fees to cover cost if requestor provides insufficient identifying information.)

NOTE: The costs of the above vital records are for both certified and uncertified copies. Requesters must provide identification and demonstrate direct and tangible interest to receive certified copies. Searches of vital records are \$7 regardless of whether or not the record is found.

Military Discharges: These are filed and copies are made for veterans free of charge. Only the veteran or dependents, county veterans service officer, Department of Veteran's Affairs, or a person with written authorization from the veteran discharged or dependents, may receive copies of his/her records and identification is required.

Genealogy Searches: The public may search open records at no charge. Record copy fees are as above. Identification is required. Genealogists must register before searching.
