## **Float Social Worker**

Iron County Human Services has an opening for a Social Worker that will float between social work positions as needed to include children and adult services. This includes a variety of child welfare services, including child protection services and youth justice as well as crisis services for children and adults and adult protective services. This Social Work position will perform casework activities which includes intake, investigation, placement, ongoing case management and supervision of children, as well as to provide services to those who are aging, physically disabled, developmentally disabled, mentally ill, and individuals dependent on alcohol and/or drugs. Health insurance and other fringe benefits are a part of the County benefit package.

**Descriptions of Duties**: Receive reports of child/elder abuse, neglect, or law enforcement referrals for juveniles. Provide intake, investigations, assessment, and case management services to court-ordered and voluntary cases serving children and families and adults; determine the ranges of services needed by individuals and families; attend court hearings, monitor compliance with court orders; coordinate services with other agencies/disciplines and community members; provide evening and weekend on-call services including assessment, crisis intervention, and referrals; complete case-related documents including correspondence, case decisions and referrals; provide on-going case management and monitoring of cases. The duties above are normal for this position, however, are not to be construed as exclusive or all-inclusive. Other duties may be required and assigned.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

Minimum of a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college in social work, sociology, psychology, criminal justice or other approved human services program; certified as a social worker in Wisconsin with the Department of Safety and Professional Services within two (2) years of hire; minimum of one year experience in the field of Social Work with experience in child protective service, crisis services or adult protective services preferred; valid driver's license and reliable transportation. Position requires shared on-call status including nights and weekends.
