- Engineering for the Radio Tower project.

AVL/GPS Funding – Commissioner has a deadline date of June 1st to submit a commitment and July 1st is the deadline for funding. Committee suggests installing two units and six if necessary. Currently Forest, Ashland and Vilas are not committing to installing these units. The state is looking at saving money and using less salt by installing these units. A separate account will be setup by the state for maintenance costs.
