1. Meeting called to order by Chairman Luke. Present: Luke, Wiita, Koski, and Mullard. Others present: Brunello, Nicholls, and Prenderville.
2. The committee recognized the meeting was properly posted and advertised.
3. Motion to approve the previous minutes made by Mullard, seconded by Wiita. All in favor.
4. Status of Recycling Program: Although it is not official on this date, it appears the State will be continuing the recycling program at the reduced rate we received for 2011. There will be an additional \$1,000,000 which will be distributed to eligible counties based on per capita.
5. Waste Management Contract has not been returned from Waste Management.
6. Sherman Electric Use: Mr. Luke said the meter fee could be eliminated in Sherman so Iron County Recycling would only have to reimburse the Town of Sherman for usage. The Committee will send a letter to the Town of Sherman regarding this issue.
7. Motion by Mullard, seconded by Wiita to approve advertising on the back page of the Iron County Fair premium booklet. All in favor.
8. Motion by Koski, seconded by Mullard to pay the bills as presented. All in favor.
9. Motion by Mullard, seconded by Wiita to receive and place the financial report on file. All in favor.
10. Discuss/Act on Any Further Financial Changes: None at this time
11. Public Comment: Prenderville received a burning complaint. She contacted the Mercer DNR Station, who will contact complainant. The letter written to Continental Computer Recycling informing them their freezers will be removed was returned, forwarding address expired.
