Commissioner's Report:

- Funds spent on County Roads 43% of county roads are in the Town of Mercer. The department has spent 55% of the budget toward improvements. 28% of county roads are in the Town of Oma. The department has spent 16% of the budget toward improvements. It was discussed at the meeting in September if Mercer was receiving adequate funding for the amount of roads in that area.
- The committee will not be attending the North Central Region Fall Meeting in Keshena, WI.
- November 14th is the schedule date for Peterbilt to receive the tandem truck. It will than be delivered to Stainless & Repair for the body installation.

Public Comment: Lambert was inquiring if the department would be hiring a patrolman if Forestry posted a position and a Highway individual signed for the posting. It was discussed that Highway would have to fill the position.
