IRON COUNTY RECYCLING COMMITTEE SEPTEMBER 4, 2012

- Meeting called to order by Chairman Luke: Committee Members present: Luke, Smith, and DeRosso. Others present: City of Hurley Mayor Joe Pinardi, Waste Management – Jeff Wolfe, Ken Nicholls, Sandy Brunello, and Lori Prenderville.
- 2. The committee recognized the meeting was properly posted and advertised.
- 3. Prenderville informed the Committee she was informed last week that the past practice of Iron County paying attendants who fill in at the Hurley Site by expense check needs to be stopped immediately as these attendants would not be covered by the County's insurance policy. Motion by Smith, seconded by DeRosso effective immediately only municipality employed or Waste Management employed attendants will be working at the Iron County Recycling Sites. All in favor.
- 4. Hurley Recycling Attendant Replacement: Jeff Wolfe informed the Committee that Waste Management is willing to employ one of the Hurley attendants to replace Sandy Brunello, who has been the Waste Management employee at the Hurley Site and is retiring. Ken Nicholls, a City of Hurley employee and Saturday recycling attendant, and Mayor Pinardi were very cooperative and willing to work with Nicholls schedule to allow him to work Tuesdays at the Recycling Site as much as possible.

It was agreed that Iron County Recycling would draft an ad for an attendant, have it approved by Waste Management, and pay for the advertising. Waste Management and members of the committee will interview. Waste Management will employ the attendant and pay for the necessary drug test and criminal background check that Waste Management requires.

The committee agreed to reschedule the September 19th meeting to September 26th to allow for time for attendant applications.
