

**Iron County Recycling Committee  
December 19, 2012**

1. Meeting called to order by Chairman Luke. Committee members present: Luke, Smith, Koski, Mullard, and Nasi. Others present: Nicholls and Prenderville.
2. The committee recognized the meeting was properly posted & advertised.
3. Motion by Mullard, seconded by Smith to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All in favor.
4. Motion by Koski, seconded by Smith to approve the financial report and place it on file. All in favor.
5. Motion by Mullard, seconded by Nasi to approve the bills as presented, reimburse the site attendants \$100 each for apparel necessary to do their jobs, and partially reimburse municipalities who have provided curbside recycling. All in favor.
6. Nicholls reported Mr. Ford is working out well at the Hurley site.
7. Public Comment: Prenderville told the committee that law enforcement issued citations in Sherman for littering. Some of the citations were issued for people dropping off recyclables during closed hours. Others were for dropping off solid waste. The District Attorney has entered into informal Deferred Prosecution Agreements with the people who had dropped recyclables off during closed hours. This will hopefully not discourage the residents from recycling, but remind them they can only bring recyclables during open hours.

Mullard mentioned exposed wiring at the Hurley site on the outside of the warming shed. Prenderville will ask Bill Nasi to check on it as soon as possible. Mullard would also like the trim painted on the warming shed this summer.

Mullard asked who will be plowing the recycling site this winter. Bill Nasi will be plowing for recycling. The first snowfall of the year, Mr. Nasi was not aware he would be plowing the recycling site, but has been since then.
