Motioned by Innes, supported by Innes to approve the minutes from the meeting on December 17, 2012. Motion carried.

Old Business:

• Warm Storage Building Moisture – Expecting a quote from Kevin Thompson-Industrial Ventilation Inc. to analyze and design a solution to the moisture issue. Motioned by Youngs, supported by Innes to accept the quote and move forward if under \$2,000. Motion carried.

Motioned by Innes, supported by Youngs to sign the agreement for CTH FF from Fox Lake to County Park Road 2.2 miles for professional services of roadway design \$129,815.93. Motion carried. Right-of-way plats and land acquisition is not included in this fee.

Received two quotes for land acquisition: (Doesn't include the purchase of land)

- MSA Professional Services Not to exceed \$9,000
- Steigerwaldt Land Services, Inc. \$9,650

Motioned by Koski, supported by Innes to award MSA Professional Services the contract for land acquisition. Motion carried.

Hudacek Hauling Permit CTH C – Asking permission to allow Hudacek haul 119,000lbs on CTH C from Island Lake Rd to Hwy 51. This segment of road was paved in 2012. Discussed the different psi for vehicles. Town of Carey looking to upgrade Camp 7 road in the summer. Committee gives the Commissioner authorization to grant this permit. It will be the Commissioners discretion to remove the permit weather permitting.

Commissioner's Report:

- Received a quote from North American Overhead Door \$1,825 for a door that was damaged. Three photo eyes will be installed \$678.
- McKenzie Supply and Equipment out of business. Our mower is in need of repair. Commissioner received a quote from Diamond for \$32,000. New controls and deck will be needed. Will look at Land Pride to see what they offer.
- CTH G Bridge Commissioner will meet with Jon Simonson-DNR in March for his opinion if the area warrants a bridge or culverts. STP Bridge funding 80/20 match.

Public Comment:

- Lambert inquired if we would be putting a new box on truck #23. This truck will be used as a spare so it will be patched.
- Truck and equipment bids will be opened at February meeting. Penalty \$25/day if delivery date not met.

Motioned by Lambert, supported by Youngs to approve payment of bills for January \$6,885.35. Motion carried.
