

Iron County Memorial Building Restoration Committee Minutes
April 6th, 2015

Bill opened the meeting at 5:30

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Pat verified that the meeting notice was properly posted.

Pat read the minutes from the March 9, 2015 meeting. Motion to accept made by Dorothy, seconded by Joe, and approved

COMMUNICATIONS:

Joe reported that he had information from the city of Hurley to renew our liquor license which must be done by May 22. We will have to pay an extra \$20 each for the machines downstairs.

He had a letter from Workmans Compensation Rating Bureau about needing an inspection of the building. We could get a reduction of up to \$400 due to the usage of the building. Joe will find out when they are coming and get Karen, Jeff, and Bill to be present. Liability and Workmens comp is only for the Bowling Alley as the building is covered with other insurance by Iron County which owns the building.

TREASURERS REPORT: Our bank balance is \$8,514.75

FUNDRAISERS: Even though the Silver Express wasn't at the table fundraiser, Kyle Anderson did a good job at entertaining. \$1477 was taken in. Scotti spent \$282 and refused to take more, so \$1195 was deposited. Dorothy thinks about \$500 was raised at the craft fair, but Kathy has not been available to make an accounting.

The pool tournament is ongoing; The VietNam dinner is scheduled for April 25th, a Graduation party is scheduled for May 23rd, and Klassic Kruisers have the April 19th date.

NEW BUSINESS: We are looking into the Boy Scouts doing a clean up of the yard. 4H did it last year.

Bill ordered 10 tables from Giovanoni's at \$120/table which includes delivery. Our old tables will be cleaned as well as the building after the Pool League is finished with the hall.

There is a placard downstairs with the names of folks who donated to the cost of the bowling machines. (pinsetters?)

The furnace needs parts so we have to find someone, or a company who is familiar with the system to get it repaired. We will try to hire Marcus Swartz to work with him.

June and August are totally booked and the Range Art Association has booked in July. There are two reservations in September.

It was suggested we have a "same weekend" for fundraisers---"Second Annual" etc.
