Patrolman Position Opening – Position is currently posted in the shop for ten working days. Advertisement is being published in the Iron County Miner July 23rd. Committee discussed performing an equipment test and having the commissioner select top ten applicants.

- Received DMA (Discretionary Maintenance Agreement) \$25,000 for culvert work on US2. Committee signed agreement.
- Hwy 169 culvert scheduled for August 17th & 18th. Detour will be set up on Hwy 77 and US2.
- Partial load of hardwood behind Mercer shop, Forestry will give us cord price estimate. Committee in favor of selling.

- Office Manager salary increase has been forwarded to Michael Pope. Issue will be resolved during negotiations.
- Mowing on state needs to be completed by the end of the month. Crew will continue on county roads. Mower was in shop for a cv-joint repair.
- Crew will be screening material for Town of Saxon.
- Crew changing culvert for Town of Kimball tomorrow.
- Commissioner will be looking at replacing the excavator or loader. Volvo has original tires that will need to be replaced.
