Pat read the minutes from the meeting of June 8, 2015. Joe moved to accept, Dorothy seconded, minutes approved.

COMMUNICATIONS; Joe had another call regarding the motorcycle group who plan to visit the area in June of 2016. They plan to use the Memorial Bldg. for meals and meetings for four days at \$200 per day, Monday through Thursday June 20 - 23rd. Mr. Dennis Munn submitted the only bid for the job. The paint alone will be about \$1500 and the total job about \$5500.

Bill attended a firemen's meeting to check on use of a hydrant for the washing. They said they would clean the building with firehoses but feared the power of such a procedure would knock off all the stucco. It was agreed the hydrant water could be used. The month of August would be a good time to do the job.

Motion made, seconded and approved to accept Mr. Munn's bid.
