

IRON COUNTY LAND INFORMATION COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

The Iron County Land Information Council met on Thursday, December 1, 2016 at 10:00am in the Meeting Room of the Iron County Courthouse, Hurley, Wisconsin.

Members present: Neil Martinko, Dan Soine, Todd Maki, Erika Roeder, Clara Maki, and Kathy Tutt.

Martinko called the meeting to order at 10:00am and proper publication of the meeting was acknowledged.

Motion to approve the meeting minutes from March 2016 by Soine/Tutt; carried 6-0.

Discussion of 2017 Wisconsin Land Information Grant – Martinko reported that the LiDAR and aerial images have been paid for. The Council discussed the breakdown of where grant money will go in 2017. The grant will cover electronic filing in the Register of Deeds office, including training, software, and security; continuing the remonumentation of Iron County and put out bids for contract soon; licenses for Pictometry, ArcMap, and 3D Analyst; upgrade of a Web Map for easier use by county staff and public. The council also discussed putting some funds aside for incentive for surveyor grad corners as they are found. Motion to approve the breakdown of the grant by Soine/Maki; carried 6-0.

Old Business – Martinko reported that the 2016 Land Info Plan was approved and accepted by the State. Maki reported he has been working on the corners and turning them in. Soine explained that the map cabinets for the Register of Deeds office have been working well.

Other Business – Roeder reported that the LiDAR purchased qualified us for a grant through the DNR to re-map the floodplain maps.

Public Comment – No public comment.

Next Meeting Date – the Council discussed having the meeting sometime in February when the bids for the 2017 remonumentation are collected.

Motion to adjourn by Tutt/Soine; carried 6-0.
