

**Iron County Recycling Meeting  
August 16, 2017**

1. Meeting called to order at 4:00 by Chairman Mullard. Present: Mullard, Hanson, Thompson, and Pinardi. Also present: Denny Stever, Pat Stever, Bob Lepper, Jim Whittinghill, Scott Jaeger, Prenderville.
2. The Committee recognized the meeting was properly posted and advertised.
3. Motion by Hanson, seconded by Pinardi to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All in favor.
4. Eagle Waste Update: Whittinghill and Jaeger informed the committee they were having issues at the Mercer site with bags of trash mixed in with the recyclables at the Mercer site. Stever gave Whittinghill a key to the Hurley compactor. Whittinghill is concerned about the condition of the compactor boxes. He stated the rail on the bottom is collapsing and a hinge is rusting. Whittinghill passed out a document dated February 8<sup>th</sup> that Eagle Waste originally had wanted to propose prior to the RFP being drafted. EW is proposing replacing the compactors and boxes Iron County owns with their own and charging a flat rate at each Iron County site.  
  
Mullard read the list of issues that had been mailed to Whittinghill that Iron County has had since EW took over the collection and processing for Iron County. Whittinghill stated he will answer each concern in writing.
5. Prenderville explained she did not pay Eagle Waste for the first month for the Miller Road box because EW had not picked up that box in June. Motion by Thompson, seconded by Hanson to pay the bills as presented. All in favor.
6. Motion by Pinardi, seconded by Thompson to approve the financial report and place it on file. All in favor.
7. HHW, Electronics, White Goods, and Tire Collection: Everything is in order for the collection.
8. Oma Trailer: Tabled
9. Public Comment: Bob Lepper introduced himself and said he will be attending the meetings on behalf of the Town of Sherman.
10. The next meeting will be scheduled on the third Wednesday of September. Agenda items to include grant approval, EW Update, Oma Trailer, and the HHW, Electronics, White Goods, and Tire Collection.
