Stacy has completed EPCRA outreach to the Fire Assoc. by discussing the WISER program and ERG books.

The committee discussed hosting a PIO Class this winter and future training and exercises within the county. Some include Court House security, and active shooter training. Along with a Hazmat operation refresher this winter.
