• Mack truck to be delivered next week. Burke Truck installed front-mount wing instead of a mid-mount that was specified. Committee looking to negotiate a 20% discount because it's

not what was ordered. To correct the wing position, the underbody would have to be reinstalled and a different gas and DEF tank would have to be ordered.

- Nuss wanting to pickup Truck #15, ECM part is being repaired.
- Truck #44 will be sent to I-State for repair, approx. 12days. Cost \$9,804.01 + \$750 tow.
- Looking into ideas and price estimates for Mercer Shop.
  - o United Structures, Schofield Building shell 100'x180', \$603,000, R30 ceiling, R26 walls, 2ft overhang.
  - o MB Concrete Walls, footings, 6" slab, \$156,000, additional \$13,600 for 8" slab.
- Ordered Snap-On software to diagnosis trucks. Forestry will pay a percentage.
