

IRON COUNTY LAND INFORMATION COUNCIL  
MEETING MINUTES

The Iron County Land Information Council met on Friday May 21, 2021 at 3:00pm in the County Board Room of the Iron County Courthouse, Hurley, Wisconsin.

Members Present: Neil Martinko, Joe Pinardi, Todd Maki, Clara Maki, Opal Roberts, Dan Soine, and Erika Roeder.

Martinko called the meeting to order at 3:00pm, and proper publication of the meeting was established.

Motion to approve the meeting minutes from February 1, 2021 by Roberts/Soine; carried 7-0.

Triennial Land Information Plan – Martinko asked if anyone or any department was in need of grant funds. Soine requested funding for the scanning of tract books and index. C. Maki brought up the potential to hire someone for the recovery of lost tax data from 2004-2013 from the failed storage IBM unit. The funding of more remonumentation corners is also a discussion of use of the next cycle of grant funding.

2022 Grant Application – Discussion of next remonumentation project from handout from Martinko. Discussion of funding Project C covering lands in the Township of Oma and needing 55 corners and discussion of project A from the handout covering lands from the Township of Gurney and the Township of Saxon and needing 63 corners.

Old Business – Martinko asked about a surveyor having found a corner previously placed in error, then fixing the mistake due to new evidence, should the surveyor be paid for resetting the corner. The item could not be acted on because it was not an agenda item.

Other Business – T. Maki asked how long of a time period is Red Maple Land Surveying not allowed to bid on county projects.
