Meeting called to order by Chairman Pinardi at 6:00 PM.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Discussion held on transferring authority to process Chips and TPR Cases within Iron County from the District Attorney to the Corporation Counsel. Human Services Director read statement voicing her concerns about cases dragging on for several years. District Attorney gave his version of events pertaining to child cases he has worked on for the past 5 years. Many questions asked by board members for both Human Services and District Attorney. Input also added by people in the audience with experience with child cases in Iron County. Former DA Martin Lipske suggested sticking with what you have in the county which is free to the county.

Discussion held on resolution declaring Iron County a second amendment sanctuary county. Item will be placed on the June 28th meeting of the full county board for their consideration.
