- 11. Collection of Plastic Bags: The only entity in this area that will accept plastic bags is Wal-Mart in Ironwood. The DNR suggests urging residents to buy cloth bags.
- 12. First Aid Supplies: A charge account has been established at K-Mart. Sandy Brunello, Adam Kussard, and Lori Prenderville are authorized to charge on this account. Brunello will purchase any needed supplies for Hurley and surrounding areas. Prenderville will ask Kussard to purchase any needed supplies for Mercer and Sherman.
- 13. Public Comment: The committee agreed to pay \$100 to the Iron County Fair Board for back page advertising on the Premium Booklet that is mailed to all Iron County households and to encourage residents to use cloth shopping bags in that ad.
