

Iron County Recycling Committee  
September 17, 2009

1. Meeting called to order at 5:00 PM by Chairman Luke. Present: Luke, DeRosso, Erspamer, & Wiita. Excused: Koski & Smith. Others present: Mikula, Brunello, and Prenderville.
2. The committee recognized the meeting was properly posted and advertised.
3. Motion by Wiita, seconded by Erspamer to approve the previous minutes. All in favor.
4. Motion by Wiita, seconded by Erspamer to approve the bills as presented. All in favor.
5. Motion by Erspamer to accept and place the financial report on file, seconded by Wiita. All in favor.
6. Tire Collection: Liberty Tire Collection has been called to pick up the tires.
7. Motion to approve the 2010 Grant request made by Wiita, seconded by Erspamer. All in favor.
8. Mercer Ordinance Violations: Prenderville will talk to the Sheriff's Department one more time. If no action is taken, DeRosso will speak with them regarding issuing citations.
9. DeRosso had received information from Continental Computer Recycling. Prenderville contacted them for additional information. This company provides collection of a variety of electronics including computers, cell phones, digital cameras, DVD players, microwave ovens, laptops, and remote controls (no computer monitors or television sets) at no charge to the county. The Committee would have to provide a lock for their container. Their contractors are state licensed. Motion by Wiita, seconded by DeRosso to contact Continental Computer Recycling to collect electronics at our recycling sites. All in favor.
10. Public Comment: Brunello has been receiving requests for a way to dispose of flashlight batteries. Mikula said Sherman can do without their extra cardboard container for the winter. Prenderville will contact Waste Management. A thank you from the Iron County Youth Camp was received. According to Waste Management plastic bottle caps may be recycled; Oil containers still cannot.
